

What is the problem? (Crisis)

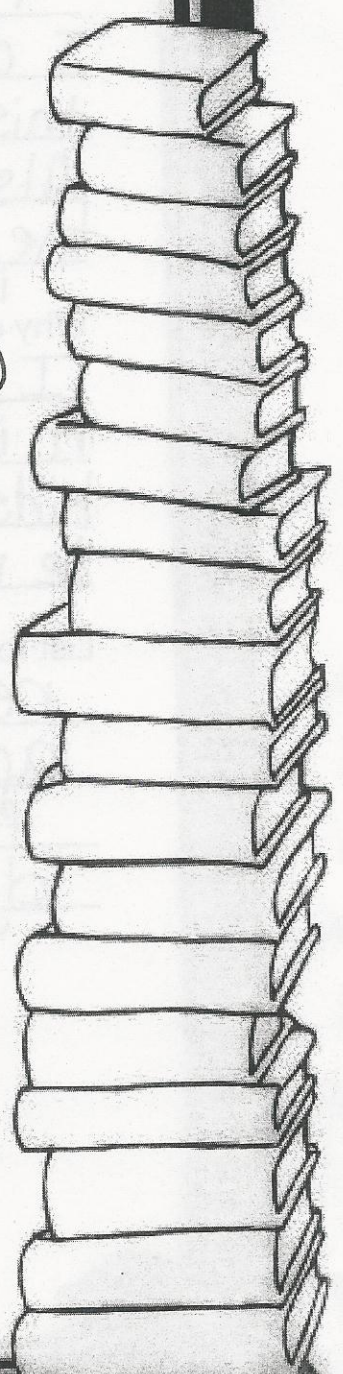
